How to use: **to talk about something that is true now**

Model Sentence: **I work for the tax office.**

### Examples:

She **doesn't live** in London, she **lives** in Istanbul.

I'm German and I **come** from Berlin.

My Dad **works** in a hospital. He's a doctor.

## The “Will” Future

How to use: **for forecasts or opinions**



Model Sentence: I think there will be about 200 guests.

### Examples:

I think that all cars will fly in the future.

She thinks that there won't be many trains to London tomorrow because of the strike.

Who do you think will win the match on Saturday?



**A** \_\_\_\_\_

still live in Colour Town  
not work for the tax office  
try different foods for breakfast  
not worry about the train times anymore

**What do you think (or don't think) will happen to Mr Tense in the future?**

*Example:* get up at the same time every morning

**Answer:** I don't think he will get up at the same time every morning.
